A meeting of the Governing Body, Sonapur College, Sonapur was held in the office of the principal at 4.30 PM on 06.06.2019 with Mr. Balaram Muellick, Sub-collector, Sonapur in chair. The following members were present in the meeting.

At the outset, the principal - cum - Secretary read out the proceedings of the last G.B. meeting held on 07.05.2019 and were unanimously confirmed. Then the agenda fixed for the meeting was placed for discussion.

Agenda 01: Extension of suspension period of the concerned employees:

The principal apprised the members that the Director's approval to the G.B. proposal as to suspension of Dr. P. L. Jena, Mr. R. N. Mishra and Mr. P. K. Bagh is still pending and the 30 days' of extended suspension period has expired on the 5th last (yesterday). The members expressed grave concern on the prolonged silence of the DHE, Odisha for giving approval to the

said proposal and the following resolution was made:
 Res. 01: "The Governing Body unanimously resolved to extend the suspension period of Dr. P. L. Jena, Mr. R. N. Mishra and Mr. P. K. Bagh for another one month, i.e. from 07.06.2019 to 07.07.2019 and the Principal was then requested to depute one senior employee of the college to the Directorate, Bhubaneswar for seeking the Director's approval to the suspension proposal submitted by the Body since long."

Agenda 02: Payment of Advance salary to Block Grant Employees.

The Principal informed the Body that the Block Grant Employees have not received their salary for the last 04 (four) months and have appealed for giving one month salary advance for maintenance of their families which will be refunded to the college soon after the salary is received from the D.H.E., Bhubaneswar. After a brief discussion, the following resolution was made:-

Res. 02: "Unanimously resolved to allow the principal for making one month's salary advance to the Block Grant employees of the college, but the same be recovered from them immediately after their salary is released from the Directorate."

Agenda 03: Appointment of Clerks and Peons:-

The workload statement for the appointment of clerks and peons in the college

was perused and the Body then decided to make the following resolution:

Res. 03: "Taking in view the fund position of the college, it was unanimously decided to appoint one (01) clerk and two (02) laboratory attendants (one for Physics and another for Botany Department), although three (03) members of peons, three (03) members of clerks and five (05) members of Laboratory Attendants posts are lying vacant in the college. The Principal was then requested to make the appointments by following due procedure and norms."

Agenda 04: Any Other:

(i) Repairing of Damaged Rooms used during the Assembly/Parliament election:

The District Administration, Sonapatna District had used ~~the~~ 06 number of rooms, viz; 07, 09, 10, 11, 14 and 15 for the purpose of last Parliament and Assembly election which had caused some damage to these rooms and also the furniture thereof. After discussion, the President, G.B. - cum Sub-Collector, Sonapatna who also happened to be the Returning Officer during the said election, assured the Body to get all the rooms and the damaged furniture repaired out of the election fund. He also assured to pay off the differential amount of the electricity Bills (both April and May, 2019), as they have also used electric equipment of

the college during the election and the counting.

(ii) Statement of Defence submitted by the suspended employees:-

The principal made the members aware of the statement of defence on the Article of charges made against them and hence the Body resolved as follows:

Res. 04: The G.B. unanimously passed resolution to form a team of 2/3 persons to examine the statement of defence submitted by the suspended employees. The team is to examine whether the replies submitted by them are sustainable/reasonable or not and also see which points of charges remain unanswered. The principal was requested to execute the same.

(iii) Some members of the G.B. led by Mr. Goerishyam Panda suggested the principal for the Identification of Students choosing a particular trade of his choice in which he/she is interested to build his/her career in future and accordingly some groups are to be formed and some teachers having interest and expertise in that field be entrusted to guide the respective group of students, so that they can excel in that line in future.

The meeting was then ended with a vote of thanks to the chair and other members.
